November 15, 2024 through May 12, 2025 – Mammoth Lakes Winter Transit service is a convenient, fun, FREE and friendly alternative to getting around Mammoth Lakes. Whether for work or play, we have a ride for you!

EVENING AND LATE NIGHT TROLLEY – The Evening Trolley (dark red line) operates seven nights a week from 5:30 pm to 11:00 pm, providing service to Eagle Lodge, Canyon Lodge, The Village at Mammoth and through town along Main St. and Old Mammoth Rd. terminating at the Community Recreation Center/Ice Rink. The route operates on a 30-minute frequency. The Late Night Trolley operates from December 13 to April 20, seven nights a week, from 10:30 pm to 2:00 am, providing service from Old Mammoth Rd. to Main St. to The Village at Mammoth, with return service to Canyon Lodge and Eagle Lodge/Juniper Springs Resort.

PURPLE / TEAL LINES – The expanded Purple Line and new Teal Line operate seven days a week from 7:00 am to 5:30 pm with stops every 30 minutes.

DIAL-A-RIDE – Unless ADA, the Dial-A-Ride service requires a fare. Priority is given to passengers with disabilities.

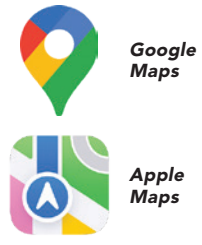
DOGS – Leashed and muzzled dogs are allowed on all routes.

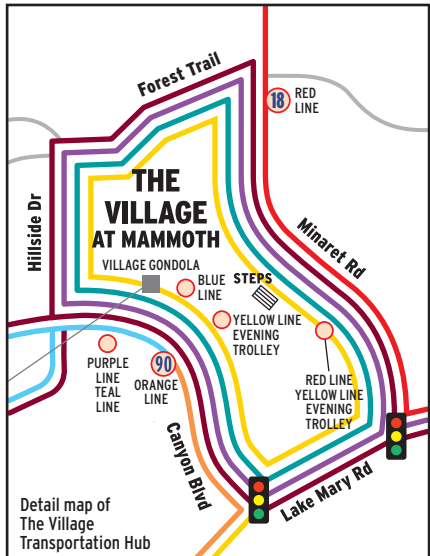
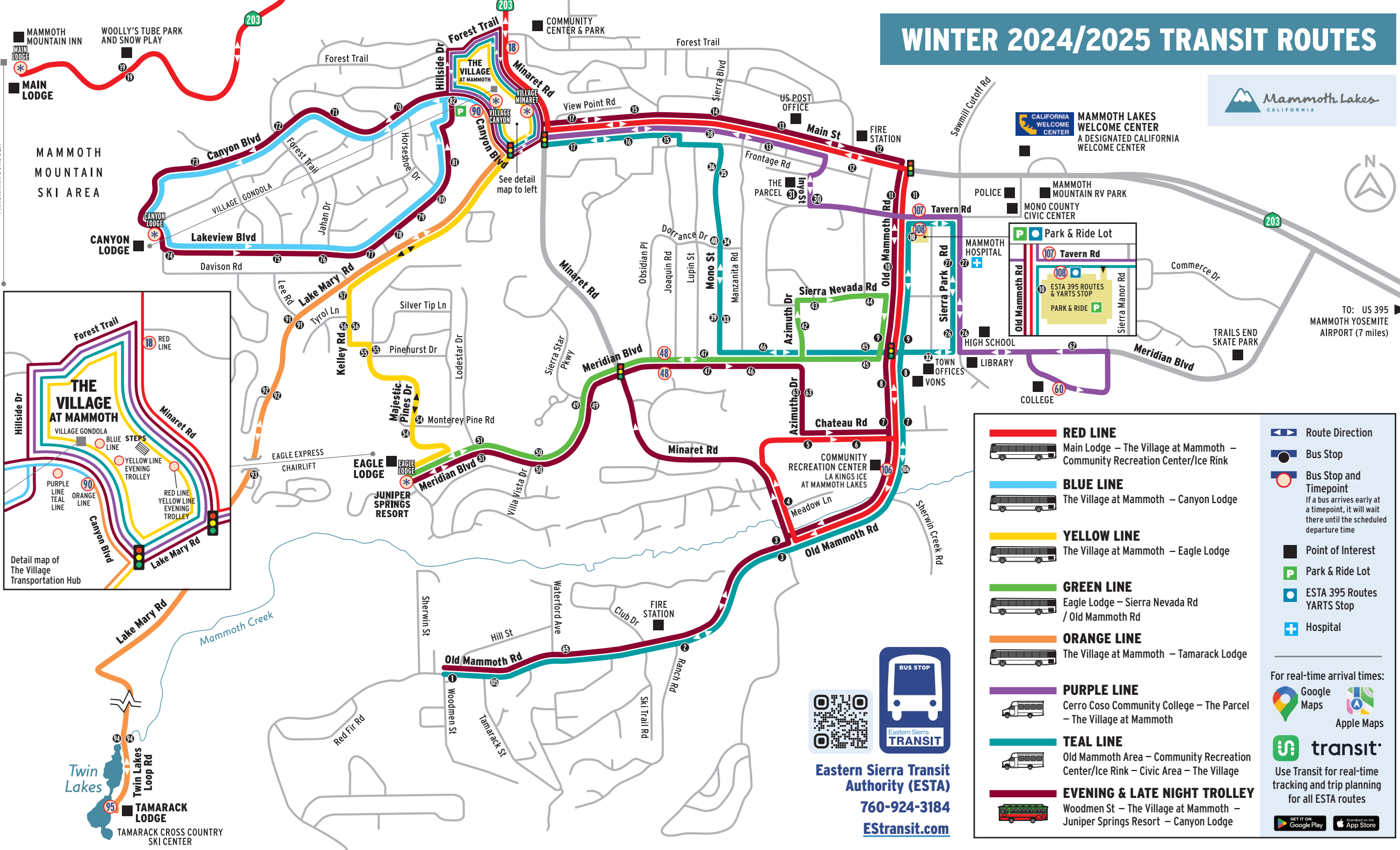
